Winner and Still Champion

Dateline – Waukesha, WI – B&M's third annual Rock, Paper, Scissors (RPS) tournament generated new records but produced familiar results. For the second year in a row, Leslie Bonk used inspiring strategy to dominate the tournament and win the Championship while setting several new records along the way.



Steve Borgwardt, the 2005 Champion and a finalist in the 2006 competition, was unexpectedly eliminated in the first round of this year's contest. Borgwardt was unable to instigate any of his famous come-from-behind victories and only managed to win a total of three throws in the first round. Bonk, the ultimate champion, sealed Borgwardt's fate by shutting him out in their first-round match.

Borgwardt, who blamed his early elimination on a "groin injury," spent the remainder of the tournament near the therapeutic margarita bar.

Bonk became the first player in B&M Tournament history to win five shut out matches. In addition to blanking Borgwardt, Bonk shut out Bruce Bartelt in both the first and the second rounds. She also shut out Heather Goeden in the second and Championship rounds.

Bartelt set a new personal best making it to the semi-final round. But his tournament run stopped there as he managed only a single winning throw against Goeden and not winning any throws against Bonk. Following Bartelt's loss the IT department took control of the margarita bar.

Although Goeden showed impressive skill in making it to the finals, she appeared completely off her game against Bonk, not winning a single throw.

While past tournaments have been marked with nail-biting comebacks, multiple tie breakers and thrilling upsets, Bonk tore through this year's field, completely eliminating any drama. Bonk won her last seven throws in a row, breaking her own record of six consecutive winning throws set in 2006. A slurred rumble of "boo's" could be heard coming from the vicinity of the margarita bar when Goeden's final "paper" was beaten by Bonk's "scissors."

Bonk retained the prestigious traveling RPS trophy and received a \$25 gift certificate to Pedro's Restaurante.
